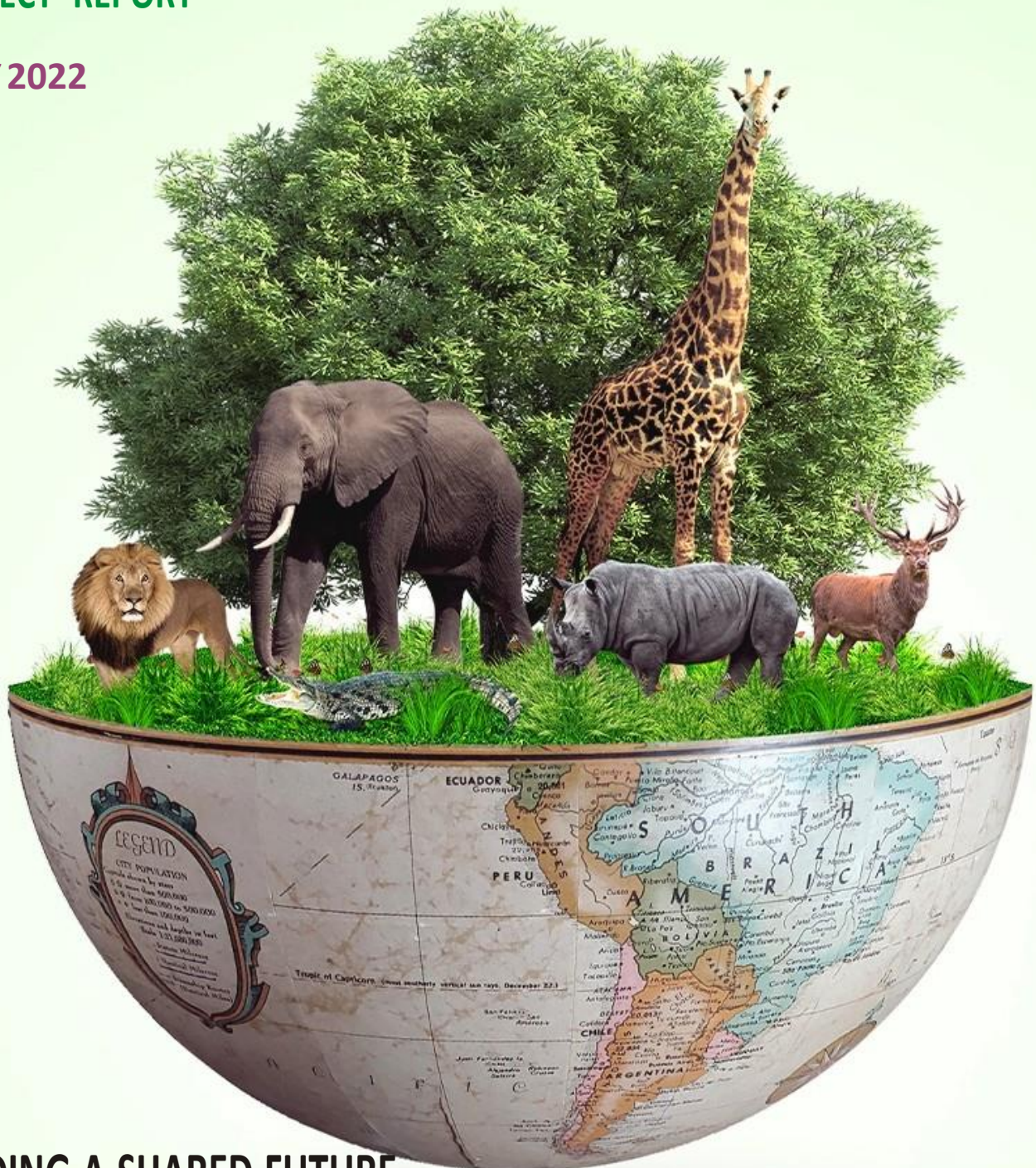

BIODIVERSITY SCHOOL OUTREACH AND TOUR

We held an educative outreach on Biodiversity in three secondary schools named below:

1. Olomu Secondary School, Otorere Olomu, Ughelli South L.G.A, Delta State.
2. Okpare Grammer School, Okpare, Ughelli South L.G.A, Delta State
3. Emeragha Secondary School, Emeragha, Ughelli North L.G.A, Delta State.
